

Hi Neighbors,

Last week the Sunset Hills Neighborhood Association had a board meeting and the newly created Sunset Hills Centennial Celebration Committee met this past week. I have included some notes from both of the meetings below.

### **Sunset Hills Neighborhood Association Board Meeting**

- **Tree Reforestation**

In March 2020 the board voted to allot \$4,000 towards a proposed tree reforestation plan. Since then 26 trees have been planted and \$2,428 has been spent. The price of trees have risen, but the board agrees this program should continue until the money voted on is used and a reevaluation of the program can be done later. \$665 has been collected in application fees and that money was voted to be combined with the original voted amount for tree reforestation, allowing \$4,665 towards the tree program. Applicants who have not received a tree yet will be prioritized over properties requesting more than one tree. Overall, the board is pleased with the way the program is running and encourages neighbors to apply for a tree if one suits their property.

- **Transportation**

Traffic and road safety has been a concern lately. There are changes being made at GDOT and it may be beneficial for Sunset Hills to have a strong committee to help address the residents' concerns. If any neighbors are interested in joining the committee, please reach out. The board may invite GDOT to attend the January board meeting.

- **Board information**

The board has decided that meeting more frequently will benefit the neighborhood and will start meeting monthly. Troy Hopkins has submitted a resignation for the role of historian and nominated John Kelly to serve. The board accepted both motions unanimously.
